- Professional development series

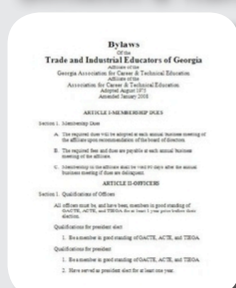
